The Tacoma Athletic Commission (TAC) proudly announces Leah Magee and Zak Gregg from Pacific Lutheran University as the 2020 College Athletes of the Year. The TAC formed in December 1942 and has been celebrating amateur athletics and recognizing local athletes for generations.

Leah Magee dazzled opponents with her ball handling skills, her grit, and passion for the game of soccer. Magee was a First Team All-Conference selection for the third consecutive season while also earning Second Team All-West Region honors, guiding the Lutes to their fourth consecutive NWC title. Magee was an NWC Offensive Player of the Week Award winner, finishing second on the team and third in the conference in both goals (eight) and points (20) while leading the team with four game-winning goals.

The TAC enthusiastically names Leah Magee as the 2020 College Athlete of the Year from Pacific Lutheran University.

Zak Gregg's passion for soccer and his pursuit of excellence was infectious. Gregg was named First Team All-West Region and First Team All-Conference while becoming the first player in NWC history to win NWC Freshman of the Year and NWC Offensive Player of the Year in the same season. Gregg made 20 starts on the season, leading the NWC Champion Lutes and the conference in goals (16), game-winning goals (four), and points (34).

The TAC enthusiastically names Zak Gregg as the 2020 College Athlete of the Year from Pacific Lutheran University.
