The Tacoma Athletic Commission (TAC) proudly announces Alvin (AJ) Johnson and Kelli Callahan from the University of Puget Sound as the 2020 College Athletes of the Year. The TAC formed in December 1942 and has been celebrating amateur athletics and recognizing local athletes for generations.

Alvin (AJ) Johnson has played football for three years, and basketball, and track the past two years. He will return to the Logger's football team in the Fall of 2020. While he was a standout in all three sports, he is most remembered for his exploits on the gridiron. Johnson broke his school record for receiving yards in a season (1,147). He also became the first Logger in school history to reach 100 receptions in a season (102). Johnson had five games with more than 100 receiving yards during the 2019 season, including 280 receiving yards in a game against Pacific.

The TAC recognizes and congratulates Alvin (AJ) Johnson for his incredible accomplishments as an amateur athlete at the University of Puget Sound.

Kelli Callahan's accomplishments as a swimmer are extraordinary. During her senior season, Callahan claimed her third consecutive Northwest Conference Woman's Swimmer of the Year honor and was named the Northwest Conference Women's Swimmer of the Week four times. Callahan holds Puget Sound records in the 200-IM, 400-IM, and 100-breaststroke. After her freshman year, Kelli did not lose an individual race in conference championship meets. Kelli is also a College Swimming & Diving Coaches Association of America (CSCAA) All-American.
